Ohio Dog Breeders Act - Senate Bill 130 became effective in Ohio in March 2013 and requires licensing for all commercial dog breeders, defined as those who produce 9 litters of puppies and sell 60 dogs/puppies in a calendar year (both requirements must be met for the law to apply). Licensing requirements include obtaining a surety bond or liability insurance, submitting to a background check, and filing an affidavit that confirms compliance with the standards of care.

This law requires rescues to register with the state. Rescues are not required to comply with any of the other requirements set out for commercial dog breeders, and there is no charge for the registration. 

# Does APHIS' New Retail Pet Rule Impact Me?

On September 10, 2013, the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) announced it was revising the definition of retail pet store under the Animal Welfare Act (AWA) to ensure breeders and Internet-based businesses selling pet animals sight unseen to buyers provide their animals with humane care and treatment and are licensed and inspected by APHIS.

If you sell dogs, cats, or exotic pocket pets that are born and raised on your premises where buyers can physically observe the animals before or during purchase, you do NOT need a USDA license.

Also, if you sell birds, rats, mice, amphibians, and reptiles, you do NOT need a USDA license.

If you do not sell your animals in face-to-face transactions, you may fall under this new regulation and need a USDA license. Please use the following checklist to help make that determination.

There is no discount for the test, but the tests will be shipped together, saving on shipping costs. There will be a \$10 charge for the on-site blood draw. You can pay for the test online with a credit card or submit a check (to: U of MN Diagnostic Lab) with the form and blood sample.

NOTE: if also doing OptiGen testing, one blood draw fee will cover both tests
